Our approach is demand-driven: we link with the private sector and plan forestry interventions with supply chain needs at the core. We partner with communities to develop and test site-specific solutions, from reforestation with fast-growing tree species to non-timber forest products and agroforestry. We aim to restore ecosystems and create livelihood opportunities for local communities on the ground, while contributing to climate crisis mitigation and creating added value along the value chain.

FVW is looking for two people to fill the position of Digitalization and Technology Officer to assist the implementation of smallholder forestry projects in Central Kalimantan. FVW works to help farmers reforest degraded lands with fast-growing tropical sengon trees and other light woods. FVW works with farmer groups through the Farmer's Field School method and promotes agroforestry and biodiversity on smallholder farms. This position will report to the Data Manager. FVW will lead the data team in Central Kalimantan to support farmer groups and coordinate the management and analysis of test plots.
